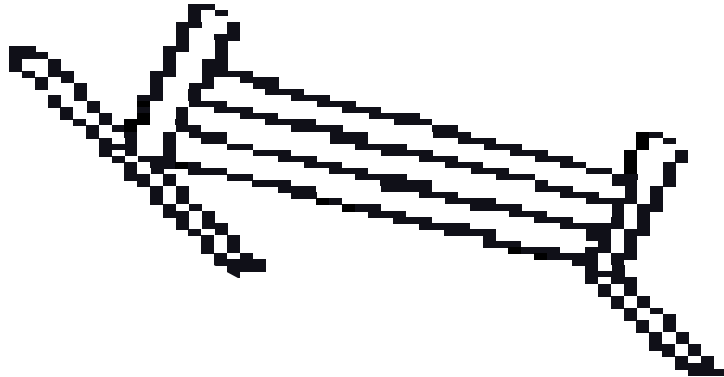

Check in and measuring: Check in and measuring start at 6:45 am. Please make sure your dog's AAC ID # is correct as we no longer check your number.

First dog on the line at 8:00 am.

Equipment Familiarization: Equipment familiarization will be from 6:45-7:15 am on both days for Starters dogs only. Sunday familiarization is only for dogs that didn't run on Saturday.

Move-ups: Same day move-ups will be available.



Prizes and Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for first through fourth place and rosettes/ribbons will be awarded for qualifying runs. There will be a volunteer draw each day.

Crating: outdoor crating space is available.

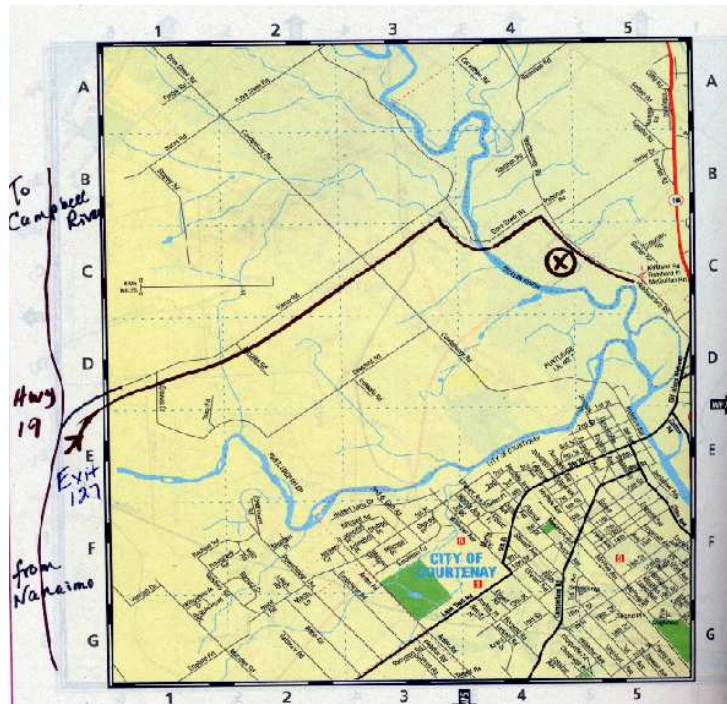

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Trial Location: The trial will be held at the Comox Valley Exhibition Grounds, Headquarters Road, Courtenay, BC

Directions coming from North or South: Travelling on the Inland Island Hwy, stay on Hwy til exit 127, the Piercy Rd exit. Follow it to Headquarters Rd, about 5.0 km. Turn right onto Headquarters Rd, follow it only ½ km, signage of Exhibition Grounds on your right, turn in main exit, follow our agility signs.

From Courtenay Centre: On Old Island Hwy travelling north, take Headquarters Road, til you see Exhibition Grounds signage

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are familiar with AAC rules and regulations, including but not limited to the following:

This event is open to all dogs at least 18 months of age, purebred or mixed breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may effect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the rules and regulations of the AAC. No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time. No toys or food on course during familiarization.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behaviour of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behaviour may be asked to leave the show grounds and no refund of fees paid will be made. Exhibitors must keep crating and exercise areas clean. Please pick up after yourself and your dogs.

There will be no refund after the closing date for dogs that are withdrawn, with the exception of bitches in season or sick/injured dogs if we are provided with a vet's certificate.

To qualify for entry, the General Agreement must be signed and this entry must be received with payment by August 29, 2015. Please ensure that your entry is completely and legibly filled out or the entry may be discarded.

All entrants are required to volunteer at the trial. Please specify your preferred jobs on your entry, and you can sign up on day of event
